Burkina Faso

Burkina Faso has been affected by a multidimensional humanitarian crisis due to insecurity, demographic pressures, climate change, political fragility and economic and health crises. To strengthen resiliency across the country, Compassion Burkina Faso has worked with more than 350 of our church partners to provide food and agriculture support as well as income generation coaching and assistance. ***Please pray for this important intervention as it enters its final few months with specific milestones planned around monitoring and evaluation. We ask that you pray that God will bless the efforts of all those who have participated in this intervention. Please also pray that our staff in Burkina Faso will be able to learn and grow from this experience and document best practices for the future.***



Ethiopia

Ethiopia has faced ongoing conflict, drought and flood emergencies that have resulted in the displacement of millions of people across the country. As of October 2023, the number of displaced people was estimated to be around 4.6 million across the 12 regions of the country. Over the next four months, Compassion Ethiopia will be purchasing food items and distributing them to participants, center staff and targeted communities in these affected regions. ***Please pray that all the logistics required for the purchase of supplies and the distribution to those in need goes smoothly. In addition, please pray for safe travel for all involved.***



Haiti

In Haiti, recent struggles with political instability, gang violence, unemployment and extreme weather have only worsened an already very challenging situation, with far-reaching and negative impacts on the nation's food security. In response to this crisis, Compassion Haiti is working to equip caregivers with critical income generation skills. Over the next few months, Compassion Haiti will roll out a micro loan program that will help caregivers expand their businesses and better provide for their families. ***Please pray that these caregivers will be equipped with all the knowledge, training and resources they need. Pray also that God will provide abundantly for these families and will break the cycle of poverty for future generations.***
